PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE


Thakeham is committed to reducing carbon emissions and delivering ambitious sustainability goals.

From 2025, all our new homes will be both carbon neutral in production and net zero carbon, meaning that carbon emissions from heating, lighting and cooling are zero or lower.

Our holistic approach means we integrate zero carbon homes, active travel solutions, biodiversity enhancement schemes, water efficiency and community-owned assets across all our developments.

Thakeham is a carbon neutral business, encompassing everything from business travel, fuel used on construction sites and the energy used in our offices.

We are currently delivering zero carbon homes for Waverley Borough Council and, in 2020, our The Martingales scheme in Bookham, Surrey, was independently assessed by Surrey Wildlife Trust's ecology services as having achieved a biodiversity net gain of 41.38%.

BUILDING STRONG COMMUNITIES

Woodgate, our 619 home scheme in Pease Pottage, West Sussex, exemplifies our community-first ethos. Early in the development, as the foundation of great placemaking, we built a brand new £4m primary school, £2.7m over the Section 106 requirement, as well as £7m of infrastructure.

We have developed and donated a community hub in the heart of the area that's owned and run by a local hospice to support their fundraising and community outreach. This includes a cafe and multi-use spaces, as well as a shop that will be run by the community, for the community, with the support of the Plunkett Foundation.

With a pioneering approach to placemaking, Thakeham developments can include schools, healthcare facilities, sports amenities, integration of community-owned and run shops, cafés, allotments, co-working spaces and open green spaces.
